**Milestone 1**

- Apply current screening guidelines dependent on patient demographics and risk profile (scholar, medical expert)
- Counsel patients on HIV prevention, including the use of Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) (communicator, medical expert, professional)
- Utilize appropriate and non-judgemental language to collect a patient's personal risk history including sexual and substance use histories (communicator)
- Organize Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) using knowledge of local systems and processes (collaborator, medical expert)
- Order appropriate initial work up for a patient with a new HIV diagnosis (medical expert)
- Communicate to patients the results of their HIV related investigations in a safe and culturally resonant manner and determine collectively what appropriate actions to take, such as genetic testing, initiation of opportunistic infection prophylaxis, change of ARV regimen (medical expert, communicator, collaborator)
- Collaborate with HIV care team (pharmacists, peers, social workers, dietitians, nurses, outreach etc.) to optimize HIV care for patients (collaborator, communicator)
- Describe first line HIV treatment options (medical expert)
- Present an approach to delivering an HIV diagnosis to a patient (communicator, medical expert, professional)
- Initiate ARV treatment and arrange for appropriate follow up care (manager, collaborator, medical expert)
- Use drug interaction software to safely prescribe medications to someone on ARVs (medical expert)
- Identify patients who require additional supports and mobilize resources (collaborator, advocate, manager, communicator)
- Perform preventative care for those living with HIV, utilizing evidence of increased risk for chronic disease, malignancies, and mental health disorders (medical expert)
- Counsel patients regarding fertility, prevention of transmission, and obstetrical care (communicator, medical expert)
- Write effective letters of support for clients requiring specialized services and resources (advocate, collaborator)

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Discuss literature pertaining to HIV related stigma and its intersections with race, colonialism, gender, sexual-orientation, and age (scholar)
